Serbia, Lake Palić, May 2 – 6, 2007

NOTICE of RACE

1. VENUE

- 1.1. South East European Open Optimist Championship will be held at Lake Palic, at the north of Serbia, near City of Subotica, from May 2nd to 6th, 2007.
- 1.2. The race office will be at the Sailing Club »Palic«.

2. RULES

- 2.1. The regatta shall be sailed under the following rules: ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing 2005 – 2008 (RRS) (except as altered by the Sailing Instructions and any supplementary Sailing Instructions); Current Optimist Class Rules; Notice of Race; The Sailing Instructions and their amendments.
- 2.2. If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

3. ADVERTISING

- 3.1. The Regatta is predicted as Category C event in accordance with ISAF Advertising Code. (ISAF Regulations 20.)
- 3.2. Boats should display advertising of the event sponsors, if required by the Organizing Authority at the both sides of her hull.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1. The regatta is open to all optimist sailors who comply with the ISAF Eligibility Code.
- 4.2. Organizer will cover accommodation and food for five competitors, one Coach and one Team leader per country. Each country may enter 5 sailors with a maximum of 4 being of the same gender. All of above mentioned will be provided of the first come, first serve base.
- 4.3. Any additional sailors or team support members will pay for accommodations during the event period.

5. PROGRAMME

5.2. The series shall consist of up to 12 races, of which three must be completed to constitute a Championship.

5.3. There will be no more than four races per day.

6. MEASUREMENTS

6.1. At the organizer request each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available to each competitor after registration.

8. COURSES

8.1. The courses to be sailed will be posted in Sailing Instructions.

9. PENALTY SYSTEM

9.1. Appendix P will apply.

9.2. Decisions of the International Jury will be final as provided in rule 70.4.

9.3. The members of the International Jury will be known before April 15th, 2007.

10. SCORING

10.1. The Low Point System of RRS Appendix A shall apply.

10.2. Each boats total score will be the sum of her scores for all races except that when 8 or more races have been completed, her 2 worst scores shall be excluded or if only 4 or more but less than 8 races have been completed, her single worst score shall be excluded.

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

11.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race.

11.2. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12. INSURANCE

12.1. Competitors shall produce a valid third-party liability insurance.
